1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as confidential as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. On 30 June 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 043" containing 20 items and "Pre-Trial Other package 012" containing 102 items.
- 4. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 043" consists of witness documents that are deemed material to the preparation of the Defence.
- 5. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Other package 012" consists of non-witness documents including open source material and documents relating to witnesses P-0454, P-0465, P-0534, P-0560, P-0972, P-0973, P-1337, P-1443, P-1457, P-1478, P-1479, P-1501, P-1515, P-1551 and P-1575. The Prosecution provides these items for the sake of completeness as part of its ongoing review of the evidence and under the legal classification of "Other" as they do not obviously include information material to the preparation of the Defence under rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
