#### I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber V ("Chamber") of the appointment of Ms Claudine Bagaza-Dini ("Ms Bagaza-Dini") as Legal Adviser to Witness P-0954 ("Notification of Appointment"), pursuant to rule 74(10) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules").

#### II. Classification

2. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court ("RoC"), the annex to the present submission is classified as confidential, as it contains personal information and contact details of Ms Bagaza-Dini.

## III. Applicable Law

3. The Registry has considered the following provisions: article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74(10) of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel ("Code").

## IV. Submissions

4. On 12 May 2022, the Registrar appointed Ms Bagaza-Dini as the Legal Adviser to Witness P-0954.<sup>1</sup> Ms Bagaza-Dini will be duly provided with access to relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of interviews of Witness P-0954, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain confidentiality at all times.<sup>2</sup>
