Klein & Mason Driver Services Facility Closed Until Wednesday, Aug. 4

Out of an abundance of caution, the Klein & Mason Driver Services facility (316 N. Klein St.) is closed until Aug. 4 as a precaution because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19.

According to the Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines, employees who work at the facility are being quarantined for 14 days. The facility is scheduled to be cleaned and sanitized according to CDC guidelines.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended expiration dates to Jan. 1, 2022 for driver's licenses and ID cards so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

In addition, White continues to urge the public to consider using online services when possible instead of visiting a facility due to heavy customer volume. White has greatly expanded online services and encourages the public to visit his office's website at www.cyberdriveillinois.com. Many transactions can be conducted online, including the purchase of license plate stickers, obtaining a duplicate driver's license or ID card, and renewing driver's licenses and ID cards, including Real IDs, for those who are eligible.

As a reminder, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has extended the federal REAL ID deadline to May 3, 2023.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required for road exams.

Drivers can visit the Dirksen Driver Services facility, located at 2701 S. Dirksen Parkway.
