Signals at Rantoul intersection to be covered June 2

As part of traffic study at Grove Avenue and Lon Drive

RANTOUL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the traffic signals at the intersection of U.S. 136 (Grove Avenue) and Lon Drive in Rantoul will be covered June 2.

The signals will remain covered for 90 days as part of a traffic study to investigate the possible permanent removal of the signals. Stop signs will be placed to safely guide traffic through the intersection during the traffic study.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 2,500 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Three of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$8.6 billion of improvements statewide on 4,422 miles of highway, 412 bridges, and 621 additional safety improvements.
