Illinois 57 at Marblehead bridge to close next week

QUINCY – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the closure of Illinois 57 at the Marblehead bridge over Mill Creek in Adams County will occur from 10 a.m. to noon Monday, April 19, and Wednesday, April 21.

The closures are necessary for repairs to the bridge. Additional closures may be needed but specific days and times have not been determined. Motorists will need to find alternate routes. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
