## Chicago Road closing at rail crossing Nov. 1

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that repairs to the Canadian National Railroad crossing on Chicago Road (Illinois 1), north of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street, in Chicago Heights, will require a full closure starting, weather permitting, 9 a.m. Monday, Nov. 1.

A detour will direct motorists to U.S. 30 (Lincoln Highway), State Street and 26<sup>th</sup> Street. The work is expected to be complete by 9 a.m. Sunday, Nov. 7.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to detour signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
