## Ogden Avenue resurfacing begins April 8

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a resurfacing of Ogden Avenue (U.S. 34), from Beaumont/Shandrew Drive to south Aurora Road, in Naperville, will require daytime intermittent lane closures, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, April 8.

The \$1.9 million project, which consists of resurfacing the 2-mile stretch of Ogden Avenue, modernized traffic signals, constructing new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps and replacing deteriorated curbs, is expected to be completed in September.

Access to residences and businesses within the work zone will be maintained throughout construction.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,000 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of Rebuild Illinois, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Accomplishments through Year Four of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$12.1 billion of improvements statewide on 5,339 miles of highway, 533 bridges and 762 additional safety improvements.
