Bridge work begins September 27 on Illinois 92 in Andalusia

DIXON – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, repairs on the Illinois 92 bridge over Hills Creek in Andalusia will begin on Monday, September 27, 2021. The bridge is located just east of 115th Street.

ERA Valdivia Contractors Inc. of Chicago is the contractor for the \$233,262 project, which will replace the bridge expansion joints. Drivers should be prepared to stop near the work zone as one lane of traffic will be maintained and controlled with signals and a barrier wall. The project is scheduled to be completed by mid-November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of Rebuild Illinois, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
