## NOTIFICATION

Webinar: Resource mobilization and the post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework:
Reflections from the Panel of Experts' report
14 December 2021

Dear Madam/Sir,

I am pleased to invite you to the webinar entitled: "Resource mobilization and the post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework: reflections from the Panel of Experts' report", organized by the Secretariat of the Convention on Biological Diversity and scheduled to be held on Tuesday, 14 December 2021, from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. (EST).

In decision 14/22, paragraph 15, the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity requested the Executive Secretary to "contract a panel of three or five experts, with equal representation from developing country Parties and developed country Parties and one from international non-governmental organizations", to prepare reports on resource mobilization "to contribute to the overall process for the post-2020 framework, and for the consideration of the open-ended working group and of the Conference of the Parties at its fifteenth meeting". Accordingly, the expert panel prepared, for consideration by the third meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation (SBI 3), the following documents:

a) <u>CBD/SBI/3/5/ADD1</u>, a summary of the evaluation and review of the strategy for resource mobilization and Aichi Biodiversity Target 20, whereas document <u>CBD/SBI/3/INF/2</u> provides the full report; b) <u>CBD/SBI/3/5/ADD2</u>, a preliminary estimation of resources needed for implementing the post-2020 global biodiversity framework, with document <u>CBD/SBI/3/INF/5</u> providing the technical annexes; and c) <u>CBD/SBI/3/5/ADD3</u> a contribution to a draft resource mobilization component of the post-2020 global biodiversity framework as a follow-up to the current strategy for resource mobilization.

The webinar will present the updated and final report on the estimation of resources needed for implementing the post-2020 global biodiversity framework, taking into account the assessment of the amount of funds needed for the implementation of the Convention and its Protocols during the eighth replenishment period of the Trust Fund of the Global Environment Facility, prepared in accordance with decision 14/23. The webinar will also provide background information on the methodologies used for the estimates and position the report in the broader work of the expert panel.
