Participation in the online informal consultations on resource mobilization 7 and 9 June 2022

Dear Madam/Sir,

I am pleased to inform Parties that, as part of the informal consultation process agreed upon by the Subsidiary Body on Implementation, in its [recommendation SBI-3/6](#), paragraph 3, two informal consultations on resource mobilization open to all Parties are scheduled to be held, in a virtual setting, on Tuesday, 7 June 2022, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. (EDT) and on Thursday, 9 June 2022, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. (EDT).

These informal consultations will be based on the concepts reflected in the section of recommendation 3/6 entitled “Additional elements on resource mobilization”, and reflected in the proposed resource mobilization component provided in annex I of recommendation 3/6, with a view to enhancing mutual understanding of the issues at hand and of the expectations by the Parties, and to explore opportunities for convergence. The informal consultations will be facilitated by the co-chairs of the SBI 3 contact group on resource mobilization and the financial mechanism, Mr. Shonisani Munzhedzi and Ms. Ines Verleye, and will be conducted in English only. A background note will be made available beforehand by the co-chairs to facilitate the informal exchanges among Parties during both sessions.
