Location: The alley behind 4800 - 4848 N. Winthrop Avenue

(W. Lawrence Avenue to W. Ainslie Street)

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm, continuous 24/7 alley closure

Work Activity: Drilled Shaft Installation

Local Impact:

- Crews will work north to south.
- The alley will be closed at all times.
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between W. Ainslie Street and W. Lawrence Avenue during this closure.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.

- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise and vibration from drilling and hauling material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
