Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. Dates: Monday, October 18 to Thursday, October 21, 2021

Location: W. Argyle Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 8pm-Monday to 7pm-Thursday (Continuous around the clock work)

Work Activity: Viaduct Demolition

Local Impact:

- W. Argyle Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- Sidewalk closures under the CTA tracks will alternate between the north and south sides of the street.
- Access to businesses on W. Argyle Street will be maintained.
- Access to the Argyle station entrance will be maintained at all times.
- Residents south of W. Argyle Street will need to access the alley via W. Ainslie Street.
- Residents north of W. Argyle Street will need to access the alley via W. Winona Street.
- There will be noise while work is being performed:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from viaduct demolition
 - o Running air compressors, excavators, and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Beeping for backup alarms on vehicles
