## **Roscoe Street**

- The parking lane on the north and south side of W. Roscoe Street will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work is completed.
- The sidewalk on the south side of W. Roscoe Street will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work is completed.

## **Sheffield Avenue**

- The parking lane on the east and west side of N. Sheffield Avenue will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work is completed.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including nighttime noise on weekends. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Running air compressors and generators
  - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
  - Metal on metal material handling
  - Noise from rail equipment, crane and maintenance equipment
  - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
