We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Thursday, July 29, 2021

(Backup dates: July 30 and 31)

Location: W. Ainslie Street on the east side of the CTA tracks to N. Winthrop Avenue

Work Hours: 9am to 4pm

Work Activity: Crane Lifts

Local Impact:

- W. Ainslie Street between the CTA tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic.
- One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance if necessary.
- Alley access via W. Lawrence Avenue to the south and W. Argyle Street to the north will be maintained.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.
- If you need further information about alternative parking and temporary parking passes, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from rail equipment and a crane
 - Beeping for backup alarms on vehicles
 - Flagging horns
