Location: The alley behind 4900 - 5062 N. Winthrop Avenue

(W. Ainslie Street to W. Winona Street)

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm weekdays and Saturdays

Work Activity: Embankment Demolition

Local Impact:

- Crews will work north to south and will block access to the alleys and garages/parking spaces during stated work hours.
- Access to garages/parking spaces will be available at the end of each workday.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.

- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- The contractor will implement the necessary dust mitigation procedures.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from embankment demolition
 - Beeping for backup alarms on vehicles
 - Flagging horns
- Extended alley closures will take place following these closures, advanced notification and additional information will be provided.
