We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Monday, September 27 to Tuesday, September 28, 2021 (Daily Closure)

• Wednesday, September 29 to Saturday, October 2, 2021 (Extended Closure)

Location: W. School Street, between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: 9am to 4pm, (continuous 24/7 closure during extended closure dates)

Work Activity: Temporary Track Steel Erection

Local Impact:

Daily Closures (September 27 – September 28)

- W. School Street between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic during stated work hours.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times, unless it is unsafe to do so.

Extended Closure (September 29 – October 2)

- W. School Street between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic 24/7.
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times.
- The contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents.

- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting
 - o Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
