One of Gloucester's runaway reindeers has made their home at the museum. Organised by Gloucester BID (Business Improvement District), each of the twelve life size creatures has been decorated in a different style. The museum's reindeer – Tilly-Rose – sports distinctive traditional Roses and Castles canal art by Sarah Roberts.

The colourful reindeer can be found welcoming visitors by the front door and once inside there's a festive trail to follow. Families can spot the Canal & River Trust mascot, Well-B, hidden amongst the exhibitions and complete the challenge to collect all the letters to spell out a festive phrase.

The museum is open from Tuesday to Saturday from 10am to 3pm. Tickets give unlimited return visits for 12 months and cost: Adult (16+) £8.50; Child (6-15) £5.00; Child (5 and under) Free; Family £20.00; Concession £7.50.
