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## I-35 crack sealing work to begin next month

Monday, June 3, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin crack sealing work on the northbound lanes of I-35 in Coffey and Osage counties. The work will start ½ mile west of U.S. 75 and continue east for 8 miles to Rock Creek.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane at the work zone with a reduced speed limit. Weather permitting, the work should be completed by late summer. KDOT awarded Parking Lot Maintenance, LLC, of Lewis, Missouri, the construction contracts totaling \$1.1 million.
