ATTENTION: Inglewood Residents and Business Customers

California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) establishes methane emissions reduction targets in a statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants (SLCP) in various sectors of California's economy. The state-mandated SB 1383 requires that all California cities implement recycling programs to reduce waste (including organics waste being disposed of in landfills). In so doing, SB 1383 now requires that you place food scraps and food-soiled paper in your Green cart; previously, the Green carts were used solely for yard clippings and green/landscaping waste; however, now, the carts will also be used for food waste.

Single and Multi-family Residential Properties:

Please collect food waste inside your residence, and place the food scraps in your Green cart for collection.

Businesses:

Please collect food waste and place them into your Brown cart for collection, this container is designated for food waste only.

If you are a single or multi-family residential property and have not been issued a Green cart, **OR** if you are a business and have not been issued a Brown cart, please **contact Republic Services at (800) 299-4898** to ensure delivery by no later than June 1, 2022.

Compliance with this mandate is mandatory and we appreciate your attention to this matter.
