### INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

#### **COMMUNITY CENTER INTERNET UPDATE**

This week, Garfield Community Center had its internet upgraded from DSL to FIOS! This exciting upgrade enables IT to implement free Wi-Fi to community members after new network equipment is procured and installed. The purchasing of these equipment is already in motion for several community centers. La Casita has also been identified as being eligible for FIOS upgrade and is next on the list. Additionally, IT worked alongside Neighborhood Services Department and visited Ganesha, Jaycee, and Willie White Community Centers to test the quality of commercial-grade cellular broadband; this is

necessary as these facilities do not have access to cost-effective hardwired internet. The results were promising with each site averaging 100Mbps+ download but varying upload between 5Mbps and 20Mbps. IT will next work with Facilities to assess optimal install locations for these modems.

#### STREAMLINING OPERATIONS

Having recently updated IT's directory service and reporting hierarchy, the team is now leveraging this data to streamline cybersecurity training. Formerly, upon new hire or departure of Staff, accounts are manually created on or removed from the City of Pomona's cybersecurity training system. Once fully deployed, accounts will automatically be created for new Staff and systematically enrolled in cybersecurity training; conversely, accounts are automatically removed from the system for departing staff. Further, reminder emails on outstanding cybersecurity training can automatically include supervisors to streamline communications. Stay tuned for more updates on how IT is modernizing business practices!

# <u>7 DAY EXTENSION REQUIRED FOR FULL STREET CLOSURE – GAREY</u> AVENUE AT RAILROAD CROSSING

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line Project, the contractor, KPJV, continues to fully rebuild the railroad crossing for the new light rail system on Garey Avenue in the City of Pomona. This required a seven (7)-day extension (minimum) of the ongoing full closure of Garey Avenue at the railroad crossing because of unforeseen issues due to weather. The full closure extension will continue through Friday, March 24, 2023. Daily work hours for this Project will be from 6:00 AM – 11:00 PM.

Access to homes and businesses on Garey Avenue within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times, as well as, access to the Metrolink station from Arrow Highway and Fulton Road or Pine Street. Residents and businesses near the Garey Avenue rail crossing are advised to anticipate construction noise.

Detour routes (green arrows shown on the map below) will be in place during the closure, and signage will be posted to direct motorists, pedestrians, and Metrolink customers. Please follow the detour signs.

#### **Detour Routes (Green Arrows seen on the map below):**

- **Towne Avenue** (northbound and southbound) will serve as the main detour
- **Arrow Highway** (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to traffic
- **Bonita Avenue** (eastbound to westbound) will remain open to traffic



#### SCHEDULED SR-71 CLOSURES FOR POTHOLE REPAIRS

As part of the ongoing efforts to keep the roads and highways operational during the construction of the SR-71 Widening Project, Caltrans will continue to repair existing potholes. These upcoming repairs will require night freeway closures, as follows:

- <u>Friday, March 24, 2023 to Saturday, March 25, 2023 from 10:00 PM 9:00 AM:</u>
  - 1. Northbound 71 from Peyton Drive to Valley/Holt Ave. ( See map below)
  - 2. Westbound 60 to Northbound 71 connector will be closed, as well as on ramps.( See map below)
    - Closed ramps on northbound 71 will be at the Chino on-ramp, Garey on-ramp, Rio Rancho on-ramp and off-ramp, and Mission on-ramp.
- Saturday, March 25, 2023 to Sunday, March 26, 2023 from 11:00 PM 10:00 AM:
  - 1. Valley Boulevard off ramp to Mission Boulevard on ramp will be closed. ( \_\_\_\_\_ See map below)
  - 2. Southbound 57 to southbound 71 connector will be closed. ( See map below)
  - 3. Eastbound 10 to southbound connector will be closed. ( See map below)
    Closed ramps on eastbound and westbound 71 would be at Valley/Holt Avenue and Mission Boulevard.
- Monday, March 27, 2023 to Tuesday, March 28, 2023 from 10:00 PM to 10:00 AM:
  - Mission Boulevard on ramp to Valley/Holt Avenue off ramp will be closed.

  - 2. Southbound 57 to Southbound 71 connector will be closed. ( See map below)


Closed ramps on eastbound and westbound 71 will be at Valley/Holt Avenue and Mission Boulevard.

#### SUCCESSFUL DISTRICTS 2 and 3 COMMUNITY CLEANUP EVENT

The Community Cleanup for Districts 2 and 3 was held on Saturday, March 18, 2023, at the Pomona Valley Transfer Station. Public Works staff, along with Councilmember Victor Preciado, attended the event.

Residents dropped off a variety of bulky items and large volumes of materials, including electronic waste (such as televisions, computers, and other electronic devices), used oil, and oil filters.

Pomona Valley Transfer Station reported 321 vehicles participated by dropping off 43.49 tons of refuse, 6.51 tons of metal goods, 44 mattresses, and 15 box springs, all of which will be recycled. Corporate eWaste Solutions also participated by collecting and recycling electronic waste, and Waste Management Curbside collected and recycled used oil and filters.
