For efficiency of processing, the North Carolina Division of Air Quality (DAQ) is hereby withdrawing its request for approval of a portion of the September 10, 2021, Group 4 rule readoption submission NC 260. In discussions with the EPA, Region 4 staff has identified that 15A NCAC 02D .0540, Particulates from Fugitive Dust, contains a reference to a portion of a state rule that is not approved into the SIP that references a federal modeling methodology. As a result, the DAQ hereby withdraws request for approval of the phrase "as provided in 15A NCAC 02D .1106(e)" in 02D .0540(a)(1) into the SIP.
