In this regular rulemaking, the California Air Resources Board amending the in-use offroad diesel-fueled fleets regulations. The changes include the following: (1) phase-out of the oldest and highest-emitting off-road engines (Tier 0, 1, and 2) from operation in California; (2) restrict the addition of vehicles with Tier 3 and 4 interim engines; (3) require contracting entities to obtain and retain a fleet's valid Certificate of Reported Compliance prior to awarding a contract or hiring a fleet; (4) mandate the use of fuel that is 99 or 100 percent renewable diesel for all fleets, with some limited exceptions; and (5) provide voluntary compliance flexibility options for fleets that adopt zeroemission technology.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 10/1/2023.
