

## **Providing Accountability Through Transparency Act—Proposed Rule Summary**

*Agency:* U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of the Interior

*Title:* Endangered and Threatened Wildlife and Plants; Removal of Roanoke Logperch from the List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife

*Docket number:* FWS-R5-ES-2023-0181

*RIN:* 1018–BH61

*Summary:* The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service proposes to remove the Roanoke logperch (*Percina rex*) from the Federal List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife due to recovery. The Roanoke logperch is a freshwater fish found in North Carolina and Virginia. It is currently listed as an endangered species under the Endangered Species Act. If we adopt this rule as proposed, the protections of the Endangered Species Act would no longer apply to the Roanoke logperch.
