## Telecube Lent Free of Charge to Mass Evacuation Shelters Following Noto Peninsula Earthquake for Use in Telemedicine ~Telecube is used for communication with local family doctors~

V-cube, Inc. (Head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo, President and CEO: Masaya Takada, hereinafter "V-cube") announces that it has loaned one of its soundproof private booths, Telecube, to Kanazawa City, Ishikawa Prefecture, which was evacuated from Wajima City after the Noto Peninsula Earthquake of 2024, free of charge.

The Telecube is installed in the Nukadani Fureai Gymnasium in Kanazawa City and allows patients to receive remote medical care from their family doctor in the Wajima area. From inside the Telecube, the user will be able to use "Videotalk," a video calling tool provided free of charge by NTTCom Online Marketing Solutions Corporation (Head office: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo, President and Representative Director: Yoshie Tsukamoto), an NTT Communications Group company, from a tablet provided free of charge by NTT DOCOMO, INC. (Head office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, President and Representative Director: Motoyuki Ii)

When you are in a mass evacuation, you will not have access to the infrastructure for daily life that you used to use in your hometown. Visiting the local family doctor is one such example. To realize remote medical care in an environment that is no different from a face-to-face encounter, an environment in which conversations cannot leak is necessary. In addition, the system must be easily installed and removed from the facility and comply with fire laws. We decided to lend Telecube, which meets all these requirements, free of charge.

We would like to express our deepest sympathies to the victims of the Noto Peninsula Earthquake and wish for the earliest possible restoration and recovery.
