### **Judge Fernando M. Camacho and Attorney Brian C. Doyle Reappointed to Judicial Conduct Commission**

---

Judge Fernando M. Camacho and attorney Brian C. Doyle have been reappointed to the New York State Commission on Judicial Conduct for four-year terms commencing April 1, 2024.

Judge Camacho, who was reappointed by Chief Judge Rowan D. Wilson, is a Judge of the Court of Claims and an Acting Justice of the Supreme Court, sitting in Suffolk County. He has been a Commission member since 2021.

Mr. Doyle, who was reappointed by Senate Minority Leader Robert G. Ort, is Co-Managing Shareholder of the Long Island office of Greenberg Traurig. He was first appointed in 2023 by Senator Ort for the remainder of the term of a deceased Commission member.

Of the 11 Commission members, four are appointed by the Governor, three by the Chief Judge, and four by the leaders of the Legislature.

Judge Camacho is a graduate of Columbia College and Fordham University School of Law. He previously served as a judge of the New York City Criminal

Court from 1997 to 2008 and as Administrative Judge for Criminal Matters, 11th Judicial District from 2008 to 2012. Justice Camacho was appointed to the Court of Claims in 2009 and has served as an Acting Justice of the Supreme Court, Suffolk County, since 2013.

Mr. Doyle is a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and the Wake Forest School of Law. He began his career as an Assistant District Attorney in Suffolk County before entering private practice. Mr. Doyle represents clients in real estate transactions, land use applications and litigated matters related to municipal determinations, construction, business and broker disputes, easements and adverse possession claims.

### **Background on the Commission**

The Commission was established in 1978 by the New York State Constitution to review complaints of misconduct and disability against judges and justices of the State Unified Court System and, where appropriate, to discipline publicly those judges found to have engaged in misconduct.

The Commission is composed of 11 members, all of whom serve without pay. The Governor appoints four members (two of whom must be non-lawyers/non-judges), the Chief Judge of the State of New York appoints three members (all of whom must be judges) and the four leaders of the State Legislature appoint one each.

The Commission has a full-time staff operating from offices in New York City, Albany and Rochester.
