## Fatal Traffic Collision – Beach Boulevard and Yorktown Avenue

On Monday, January 24, 2022, at approximately 6:20 p.m., the Huntington Beach Police Department (HBPD) responded to a traffic collision at the intersection of Beach Boulevard and Yorktown Avenue involving a pedestrian and a white Chevrolet Silverado.

Upon arrival, officers located a female deceased in the roadway whose identify is not yet being released. The driver of the Silverado, a 58-year old male from Garden Grove, remained at the scene and cooperated with officers. It does not appear that drugs or alcohol were a factor in the collision.

Based on the preliminary investigation, the Silverado was traveling northbound on Beach Boulevard and struck the female pedestrian crossing eastbound on Yorktown Avenue.

The collision investigation is ongoing and being handled by the HBPD Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT).
