# NOTEWORTHY EVENTS

  - Crimes Against Society- 148



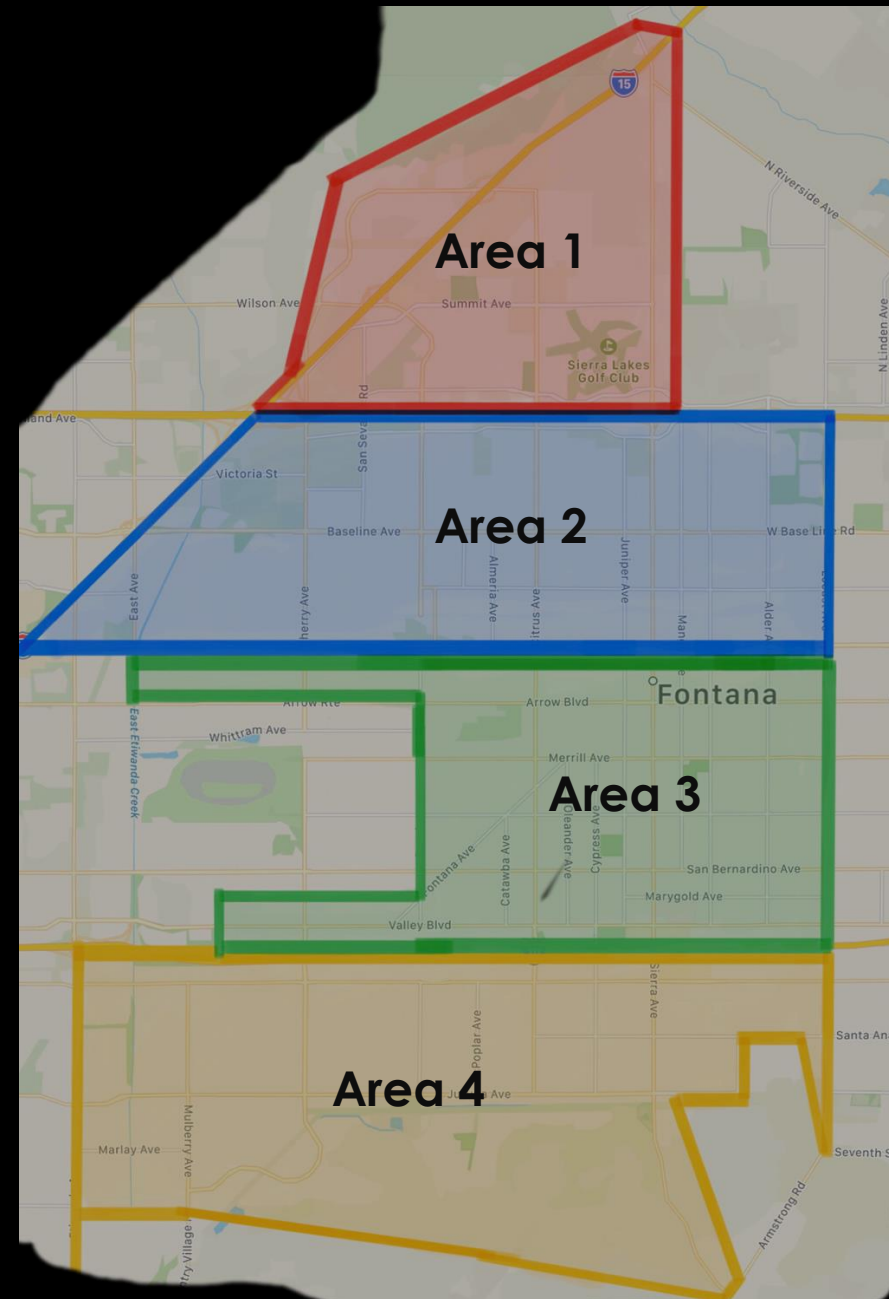
