## Unstably Housed Assistance

- With five safe parking lots and over 101 spaces, it is the largest safe parking lot program in Santa Clara County.
- In addition, LifeMoves Mountain View operates interim housing for up to 100 households experiencing homelessness.

# RESIDENTS' ESSENTIAL NEEDS

 Provided multiple sources of relief directly to residents impacted by COVID-19, including cash, gift cards, bill pays and isolation accommodations for when quarantining in the home was not possible.

#### **SMALL BUSINESS RELIEF**

#### **Small Business Action Plan**

- Designed solutions to assist small businesses during COVID-19 and strengthen their long-term resiliency.
- Includes Shop Local program and Mountain View Biz newsletter.

#### City Loans and Grants

- 71 businesses received small business microloans.
- 93 more businesses with \$5,000 grants.

#### Castro StrEATs and OMV!

- Castro StrEATs closed 100— 400 blocks of Castro Street for outdoor dining.
- Outdoor Mountain View (OMV!) allowed businesses to temporarily operate outside.
