5. ACTION CALENDAR

A. Award Agreement for Construction Management Services and Approve Solicitation of System Components for the Solids Handling Improvements Project (CIP-10059)

Recommendation:

That the Board authorize the General Manager to:

- 1. Enter into an agreement with AKM Consulting Engineers for construction management services for the Solids Handling Improvements Project (CIP-10059) in the amount of \$688,168, plus a 10 percent contingency of \$68,817, for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$756,985.
- Post Invitations for Quotation for four items: (a) Procurement of two sludge conditioning tanks;
 (b) Rental agreement for a temporary dewatering system; (c) Rental agreement for an odor control system; and (d) Procurement of electrical breakers for an estimated total of \$1,210,000.
- B. Amend Agreement W2998 with Weck Laboratories, Inc. for Chemistry Analytical, Courier, and Reporting Services
 - **Recommendation:** That the Board authorize the General Manager to amend Agreement W2998 with Weck Laboratories, Inc., with an additional contract amount of \$140,219.50 by (a) releasing the 10% contingency of \$52,219.50, and (b) reallocating a contract amount of \$88,000 from Agreement W2997 with Eurofins, bringing the new total not-to-exceed amount of Agreement W2998 with Weck to \$662,414.50.
- C. Award Agreement for Professional Engineering Services for the Phase V Membrane Filtration SCADA Upgrade Project
 - **Recommendation:** That the Board authorize the General Manager to enter into an agreement with Enterprise Automation for professional engineering services, for the Phase V Membrane Filtration SCADA Upgrade Project in the amount of \$529,879, plus a 15% contingency of \$79,482, for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$609,361.

D. Award Agreements for Supply and Delivery of Bulk and Mini-Bulk Chemicals

Recommendation: That the Board authorize the General Manager to award agreements with the following chemical suppliers, from July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025, for the supply and delivery of the following:

- a. <u>Carbon dioxide:</u> California Tool & Welding Supply to supply, deliver, and maintain carbon dioxide systems at CNTP, TRWRP and JMMCRWRP at \$0.18 per pound of carbon dioxide;
- b. <u>Ferric chloride:</u> Pennco, Inc. to supply and deliver ferric chloride to ECLWRF at \$1,224 per dry ton;
- c. <u>Hydrogen peroxide:</u> Brenntag Pacific, Inc. to supply and deliver hydrogen peroxide to ECLWRF at \$3.85 per gallon;
- d. <u>Sodium bisulfite:</u> Univar Solutions USA LLC to supply and deliver sodium bisulfite at \$0.5250 per dry pound to CNTP, TRWRP, and JMMCRWRP;
- e. <u>Sodium hydroxide:</u> Northstar Chemical to supply and deliver sodium hydroxide at \$0.3700 per dry pound to ECLWRF, at \$0.8900 per dry pound to JMMCRWRP, and at \$0.4100 per dry pound to CNTP and TRWRP;
- f. <u>Sodium hypochlorite</u>: JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. to supply and deliver sodium hypochlorite to CNTP, TRWRP, JMMCRWRP, and ECLWRF at \$1.710 per gallon;
- g. <u>Sulfuric acid:</u> Brenntag Pacific, Inc. to supply and deliver sulfuric acid at \$208.00 per ton to ECLWRF and JMMCRWRP, and \$288.00 per ton to TRWRP;
- h. <u>Hydrated lime:</u> Lhoist North America to supply and deliver hydrated lime at \$455.88 per ton to ECLWRF;
- i. <u>Mini-bulk chemicals</u>: Miles Chemical Company for the supply and delivery to ECLWRF of:
 - · Ferric Chloride, at \$0.590 per pound, and
 - Sodium Hydroxide, at \$0.375 per pound, and
 - Sodium Hypochlorite, at \$3.030 per gallon.
