Winners announced for Chance-to-purchase event

Public drawings attracts record number of entrants

PORTLAND, Ore. – The Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission (OLCC) has selected the winners for rare and hard-to-find distilled spirits in the first of four Chance-to-Purchase events planned for 2024.

This year's first quarter event ran from March 11th to 17th and attracted entries from 32,822 Oregonians; Chance-to-Purchase events are open to eligible Oregon residents only. This event offered 354 bottles, which is the largest number of bottles ever made available during the Chance-to-Purchase program.

There were 156,457 entries across all products offered and entrants were able to choose up to five different items. If a winner was selected in the separate drawings for each product type, the winner's remaining entries were disqualified from subsequent drawings in this event. All the winners have been notified of their selection.

The winners were chosen in drawings conducted by the OLCC on March 19, 2024. An auditor from the Oregon Military Department observed the selection process as part of OLCC's enhanced auditing and reporting procedures.
