Commission to hold June meeting in southern Oregon Town-hall conversation with cannabis industry also planned

PORTLAND, OR. – Next month, the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission will travel to southern Oregon and will hold its monthly meeting at Southern Oregon University in Ashland, OR. Commissioners plan to use their time in southern Oregon to hear from and interact with licensees and stakeholders in the cannabis, hospitality and wine industries.

The Commission will hold its **Wednesday, June 15, 2022**, meeting on the campus of Southern Oregon University in Stevenson Union. In an effort to directly connect with industry partners, Commissioners have invited testimony to hear directly from businesses on the current operating environment and challenges the industries are facing.
