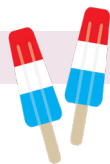

GET RESIDENT RATES WITH A RESIDENT ID CARD



A resident ID card is required to get the resident rate for Creve Coeur recreation programs. With the resident ID card, residents also receive discounts at Creve Coeur, Ballwin and University City golf courses, the Creve Coeur Ice Arena and Maryland Heights Aquaport.

Residents may purchase an ID card by visiting the Dielmann Recreation Complex during business hours between 8:00A-5:00P Monday-Friday. Please bring two forms of identification that show proof of residency (driver's license, checkbook, utility bill, apartment lease papers, etc.). Each ID card costs \$5 and is valid for three years.

PARKS & STORMWATER PROJECTS

The City collects a half-cent parks and stormwater sales tax to provide funding for local parks and stormwater control in Creve Coeur. The list below highlights significant projects completed during the past year, projects in progress, and proposed projects on the horizon!

Recently Completed Projects

- City staff have worked with engineers from Intuition & Logic to develop a citywide **Watershed Management Plan**, which will be used to plan for future stormwater infrastructure improvements.
- Adopted in November 2023, the **Venable Park Master Plan** provides a plan for park improvements, building on the citywide Creve Coeur Parks Master Plan adopted in 2019.
- The **restrooms in Conway Park and Malcolm Terrace Park** have been renovated and converted to year-round restrooms.
- The deteriorating **stormwater system under Alden Lane** was replaced, helping to stabilize the roadway and prevent future ponding.



Proposed Projects

- Once the site design work is completed, the City will begin work at **Venable Park** to add a splash pad to the park, as well as replace the trail, bridge and tennis courts. The restrooms will also be converted for year-round use.
- The **commemorative artwork** in Venable Park is scheduled to be installed during 2025.

Projects In Progress

- The **South New Ballas Road–Tarrytown Drive Channel Stabilization Project** will stabilize the roadway culvert's outfall and downstream banks to reduce risk of the roadway failing due to erosion.
- **Millennium Park** is undergoing a \$2.5 million renovation that will feature a new playground, splash pad, bandstand and entry plaza—scheduled to be completed by June 2024.
- The **Hibler Road Drainage Improvement Project** will reestablish roadway swales and install new stormwater inlets and pipes to help prevent stormwater from damaging the pavement.

The City of Creve Coeur has six beautiful parks for the community to enjoy, offering a variety of walking paths, playgrounds, athletic courts and more!

Millennium Park

2 BARNES WEST DRIVE

The newly renovated Millennium Park reopens this summer and will feature a brand new playground and seasonal splash pad. The 25-acre park also has two pavilions, a 0.6-mile paved walking trail, year-round restrooms, soccer field, softball/baseball field, a barbecue grill, and the historic Tappmeyer Homestead.

Conway Park

12301 CONWAY ROAD

This 29-acre park features a one-mile paved path, one tennis court, two pickleball courts, playground, dog park and year-round restrooms.

Lake School Park

581 COEUR DE VILLE ROAD

Lake School Park sits on six acres and features a soccer field, three lighted tennis courts, and seasonal restrooms.



Dr. H. Phillip Venable Memorial Park

10630 COUNTRY VIEW DRIVE

Spanning seven and a half acres, Venable Park features a half-mile paved trail, three tennis courts, a soccer field, two playgrounds, a picnic pavilion, barbecue grills and year-round restrooms.

LaVerne Collins Park

10581 OLD OLIVE STREET ROAD

Located along Olive Boulevard, this one-and-a-half-acre park has a gazebo and picnic tables, making it a great spot to enjoy lunch.

Malcolm Terrace Park

11370 ST. PAUL STREET

This park features 25 wooded acres with a mile-and-a-half of nature trails, as well as a playground, small picnic pavilion, sand volleyball court and year-round restrooms.
