

DRILLING UNDERWAY AT SANTY GOLD

HIGHLIGHTS

- Aircore drilling has commenced at the Santy Gold Project with a total of 61 holes for a planned ~3,000m.




Fig. 2 - Santy Project, with aircore drill plan including the Santy Gold target overlain interpreted targets and soil sampling locations.

- Drilling will commence at the Coastal target (planned 21 holes) and includes the main Santy Gold target (surface rock chips up to 100.6 g/t Au¹) with all 61 holes to be completed within three weeks (Fig 2).
- Further targeting activities have been undertaken by the Company with an 838sample soil geochemistry program completed in early-July and assay's pending.
- Samples were collected over the VMS target and the exposed portion of the main fold nose prospects on a 200 x 50m grid.

BPM Minerals Limited (ASX:BPM) (BPM or the Company) is pleased to announce that aircore drilling has commenced at the Santy Gold Project, located in Western Australia's Murchison Region.

The Santy Project has three distinct geological target areas, including:

- Northeast Anticlinal Closure: An interpreted anticline extending north-eastward into the Santy project area from Tallering Peak and interpreted to plunge to the north.
- Fault/Structural Intersection Zones: Several major fault intersection zones including the main Santy Target (surface rock chips up to 100.6 g/t Au).
- Ultramafic and Magnetic Targets: 2.8km-long magnetic high located on the
 contact between the greenstone belt to the south and the granite-gneiss terrain to
 the north. Historic Aircore Holes targeting the magnetic anomaly intersected highly
 anomalous Nickel, Copper, Cobalt, and Chromium values.



Historical drill hole TPRC001 intersected 72m @ 241ppm Cu and 131ppm Zn with sulphide mineralisation identified in end-of-hole samples².

Drilling targets were generated from an independent geological interpretation using airborne magnetics and satellite imagery, with an interpreted 80% of granted tenure under transported cover.

The Company's recently completed soil sampling program is expected to further delineate targets for follow-up drill testing.

ABOUT SANTY

Located within the Murchison Domain of the Youanmi Terran, the Santy project lies on the northeastern end of the Archaean Tallering greenstone belt, within the Norie Group, located along the western edge of the Murchison domain in the Yilgarn Craton.

Much of the project area is covered by a veneer of lateritic pisolite gravels and ferricretes, silty clays and loams, and granite-derived eolian sands. Complicated bedrock geology is interpreted from geophysical data which suggests folded magnetic stratigraphy that has been faulted and sheared, and later intruded by dykes.

Bedrock samples from historic drilling includes metabasalt, talc-tremolite ultramafic rocks, minor serpentinous ultramafic rocks, intermediate volcanic rocks, ferriginous cherts, felsic porphyries, and silicified mafic intrusive rocks.

Considering the number of rock chip samples containing visible gold that have been returned, effective exploration has been relatively limited. The project is directly along strike from Adaman's A-zone and Mixy deposits.

Access to the Project is from Geraldton via the sealed Geraldton-Mt Magnet Road to Mullewa and then northwards along the unsealed Carnarvon-Mullewa Road which bisects the project area.






Fig. 3 - BPM Minerals portfolio of Projects in some of Western Australia's most prospective greenstone Belts and Base-Metal Basins.
