With reference to securitisation transactions, the Bank of Italy has expressly provided that:


- the accounting information relating to each securitisation transaction be evidenced separately in the Notes to the Financial Statements;

- d) as far as I am aware of, they are suitable to furnish a true and fair representation of the Issuer's financial position and of the economic result of the period and the general situation.
- e) The management report includes a fair review of the development and performance of the business and the position of the issuer and the undertakings included in the consolidation taken as whole, together with a description of the principal risks and uncertainties that they face.
