Health District Offering Covid-19 Vaccines for 6-17 Year-Olds

Wichita Falls, Texas – The Wichita Falls-Wichita County Public Health District will start offering the COVID-19 vaccine primary series for 6 years of age through 17 years of age for **Moderna** for eligible populations on July 1st, 2022.

On June 17th, 2022, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved a COVID-19 vaccine primary series for 6 years of age through 17 years of age for **Moderna** for eligible populations

COVID-19 vaccines and booster are also available for eligible populations. The Wichita Falls-Wichita County Public Health District will have a COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic on Monday thru Friday 8-4:30. Walk-ins are welcome or you can visit the City of Wichita Falls website to register online or call (940) 761-6841.
