

Trials Ongoing Acquittals in 2023



In April, al-Fitr celebration in Višegrad, organized by CaH, promoted social cohesion and diversity. 600 pieces of baklava, a traditional cake, were shared with the public in front of the city mosque. At the same time, authorities in Višegrad publicly condemned a crime targeting a Bosniak couple and urged that the perpetrator be held accountable for their actions.
