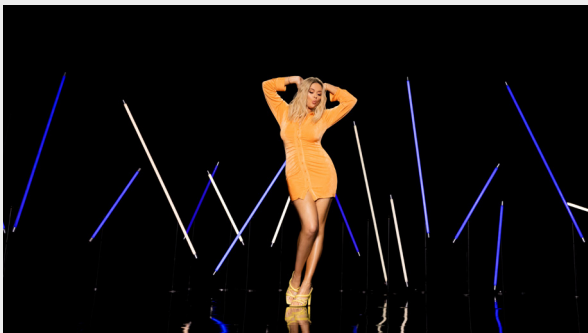




Peckham's Finest
