


The Pet Show Sunday, 5.35pm 7th November ITV




The Tower Monday-Wednesday, 9pm 8th-10th November ITV




For Real: The Story of Reality TV Tuesday, 9pm 9th November ITVBe




Scott & Bailey Monday-Thursday, 10pm Friday, 10pm & 11.05pm 8th-12th November ITV3


