During the **UEFA Euro 2020™** tournament, which starts on June 11, TF1 – one of France's official broadcasters for the competition – will broadcast **12 matches in 4K, available on the Freebox Delta, Freebox Pop and Freebox mini 4K.**

And there's nothing better than 4K (Ultra High Definition) to give you the same big match experience as if you were really there!

The TF1 4K channel is available to and included in the plans of eligible subscribers who have:

- the Free Devialet Player with the Freebox Delta;
- the Pop Player, whether they have a Freebox Pop plan or the Freebox Delta plan with the Pop Player; or
- the mini 4K Player, whether they have the Freebox mini 4K plan, the Freebox Revolution plan with TV by CANAL Panorama or the Freebox Revolution plan with the multi-TV mini 4K option.

It will also be available via the OQEE application on Samsung Smart TVs (2018 to 2021) that have Tizen 4.0 or a higher version.

TF1 4K can be accessed on channel 101. Viewers will be able to watch in 4K **as from June 11** when the first match of the tournament (Turkey vs. Italy) is broadcast on TF1 4K, and in all 12 matches will be broadcast in 4K on TF1 4K throughout the competition, which runs from June 11 to July 11, 2021.

12 of the top fixtures, including the majority of France's games, broadcast on TF1 4K

The 12 matches on TF1 4K include:

- 6 group-phase matches:

- Friday June 11, 2021 – Turkey vs. Italy, at 9:00 p.m.
- Monday June 14, 2021 – Spain vs. Sweden, at 9:00 p.m.
- Friday June 18, 2021 – England vs. Scotland, at 9:00 p.m.
- Saturday June 19, 2021 – Hungary vs. France, at 3:00 p.m.
- Monday June 21, 2021 – Finland vs. Belgium or Russia vs. Denmark, at 9:00 p.m.
- Wednesday June 23, 2021 – Portugal vs. France at 9:00 p.m., a vital match and an opportunity for France to get its revenge for the Euro 2016 final

- 3 last-16 matches including France's game if they qualify

- 2 quarter finals

- And one semi-final, including France's game if they qualify
