Japan Post, Yamato Transport Start Handling “Kuroneko Yu-Packet” Deliveries

New service to help resolve 2024 problem in logistics and environmental issues

Tokyo, October 11, 2023 - Japan Post Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President, CEO and Representative Executive Officer: Tetsuya Senda, hereinafter “Japan Post”) and Yamato Transport Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President and Representative Director: Yutaka Nagao, hereinafter “Yamato Transport”) launched the first phase of a partnership for the purpose of helping resolve various logistics-related social issues and promoting sustainable logistics services on Sunday, October 1, 2023. This partnership, which will ensure stable delivery operations, is a measure based on a basic agreement signed on Monday, June 19, 2023.

1. Overview

The partnership is an initiative intended to establish transport services that contribute to enhanced customer convenience and support business growth through effective utilization of Japan Post and Yamato Transport’s management resources, while also aiming to resolve social issues faced by the logistics industry, such as the 2024 problem in logistics and environmental issues.

2. Implementation Scheme

Yamato Transport will collect “Kuroneko Yu-Packet” packages from customers, hand them over to Japan Post’s regional sorting office (accepting packages), and deliver them to recipients’ mailboxes, etc. via the Japan Post delivery network.

Start Date: Sunday, October 1, 2023

Applicable regions: Hokkaido, Aomori Prefecture, Iwate Prefecture, Miyagi Prefecture, Akita Prefecture, Fukushima Prefecture, Tochigi Prefecture, Gunma Prefecture, Niigata Prefecture, Toyama Prefecture, Ishikawa Prefecture, Fukui Prefecture, Yamanashi Prefecture, Gifu Prefecture, Aichi Prefecture, Mie Prefecture (16 prefectures)

*The applicable regions handling “Kuroneko Yu-Packet” will gradually be expanded, with the aim of making the service available nationwide by the end of FY2024.
