Professional career

Dr. Kari Kapsch (born 1964; nationality: Austrian) joined Kapsch AG in 1982 and has held various positions in the course of his career. In 2001, Dr. Kapsch, who holds a doctorate in physics, was appointed Chief Sales and Production Officer of Kapsch AG. In this role, he made a significant contribution to the successful acquisition of the contract for the Austrian toll collection system for Kapsch AG. In 2002, he was appointed COO of the Kapsch Group and also held the position of CEO on the Executive Board of Kapsch BusinessCom AG, which later became K-Businesscom AG, between 2003 and 2010. He subsequently served as CEO of Kapsch CarrierCom AG between 2011 and 2019. He was also Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Kapsch BusinessCom AG from 2011 until 2021 and has been Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the successor company CANCOM Austria AG (formerly K-Businesscom AG) since 2021.
