HEALTHCARE IN THE TUSCANY REGION: COMPUTERISED MANAGEMENT IN THE SOUTH EAST AREA

FRAMEWORK CONTRACT OF EUR 34 MILLION AWARDED TO THE CONSORTIUM LED BY GPI

Trento, 21 June 2021

The **GPI Group** (GPI:IM), a company listed on the MTA market that is a leading provider of Information Systems and Services for Health and Social Care, is pleased to announce that it recently concluded the first agreement implementing the framework contract for the management of the assistance, maintenance and lease service for computer workstations and communications tools for Organisations within the Tuscan Regional Health Service relating to the Greater South East Area.

The project, awarded in early 2021, was assigned to the consortium led by the GPI Group and including TIM, TRII and Computer Care. The economic agreement sets a maximum value of EUR 34 million to be disbursed under individual implementing agreements. The first is equal to EUR 10.2 million for four years, with a 70% share for GPI.

Under this new contract, the GPI Group will increase the presence of its solutions and services in the Tuscany area, which it already serves through other important projects: its Local Social and Healthcare patient management system; maintenance and development of solutions within hospital information systems; and creation of the Labour Information System for the Region of Tuscany in collaboration with other companies.

GPI was listed on Borsa Italiana in 2016 (AIM segment) and moved to the MTA market in 2018.
