#### Statistics of Spaniards Resident Abroad (RSRA) 01 January 2023

### The Spanish population resident abroad increased 1.7% in 2022

### United Kingdom, Mexico, and France are the countries that register the highest increase of population with Spanish nationality

### In 2022, over three out of four new registrations corresponded to persons born outside Spain

#### Population with Spanish nationality resident abroad by continent

The number of persons with Spanish nationality resident abroad reached 2,790,317 as at 01 January 2023, according to data from the Register of Spaniards Resident Abroad (RSRA). This figure represents an increase of 1.7% (47,712 persons) as compared with the data as at 01 January 2022.

By continent, 58.7% of registered persons had established their residence in America, 37.7% in Europe and 3.6% in the rest of the world.

The largest increases in the number of registered persons in 2022 were in Europe (32,589 more) and America (19,698 more).

In relative terms, the largest increases were recorded in Europe (3.2%) and Oceania (1.3%).

### Population with Spanish nationality resident abroad by continent and sex

The number of registrations of women living abroad exceeded that of men by 23,845. By continent, America, Europe and Oceania recorded more women than men registered, while Africa and Asia recorded more men than women registered.

# Population with Spanish Nationality resident abroad by continent and age Group

15.1% of those registered in the RSRA as at 01 January 2023 were under 16 years of age, 62.8% were between 16 and 64 years of age, and 22.1% were aged 65 or more years old.

By continent, 50.5% of persons under the age of 16 years were residents in Europe and 42.4% in America. In the age group from 16 to 64 years old, 57.1% were resident in America and 39.6% in Europe. With respect to people over 65 years old, 74.5% had established their residence in America and 23.7% in Europe.


Among the countries with more than 10,000 residents, the largest increases of people with Spanish nationality in relative terms were registered in Colombia (9.6%), Panama (5.9%) and United Kingdom (5.3%).

Conversely, the Spanish population registered a decrease in seven countries: Venezuela (-2.8%), Peru (-1.6%), Morocco (-0.9%), Chile (-0.7%), Argentina (-0.6%), Uruguay and Ecuador (-0.1% in both countries)

In absolute terms, the highest increases of Spanish population during 2022 were registered in United Kingdom (9,763 more), Mexico (7,122) and France (7,109).

On the other hand, the highest decrease of Spanish population were registered in Argentina (2,694 less) and Venezuela (3,869 less)

#### Informative annex

The target population analysed in these statistics is the Spanish population residing abroad. It includes all people holding Spanish nationality—whether it is or not their only nationality— who are registered as regular residents in the Consular Office Register of their place of residence. This registration must have been communicated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to the INE, as so it can be incorporated to the central file of the RSRA.

The registrations carried out within the year before the 1st January of the reference year correspond to new registers due to any possible reason (birth, nationalization, omission and emigration from Spain abroad).

The statistical mining of the RSRA central file let us only know about the distribution of registered people and the distribution of new registrations by variable on the date of reference, but it does not provide information about the causes of the changes with respect to the previous year.

Type of operation: continuous on an annual basis.

Population scope: all persons with Spanish nationality residing abroad.

**Geographical scope:** from the point of view of residence abroad, all countries are covered; from the point of view of the municipality of registration for electoral purposes, the entire national territory is covered.

Reference period: on 1 January of each year.

**Collection method:** comprehensive from an administrative register.
