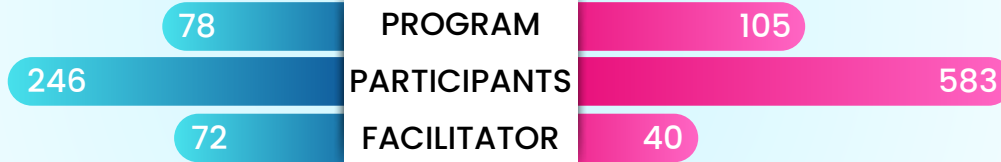

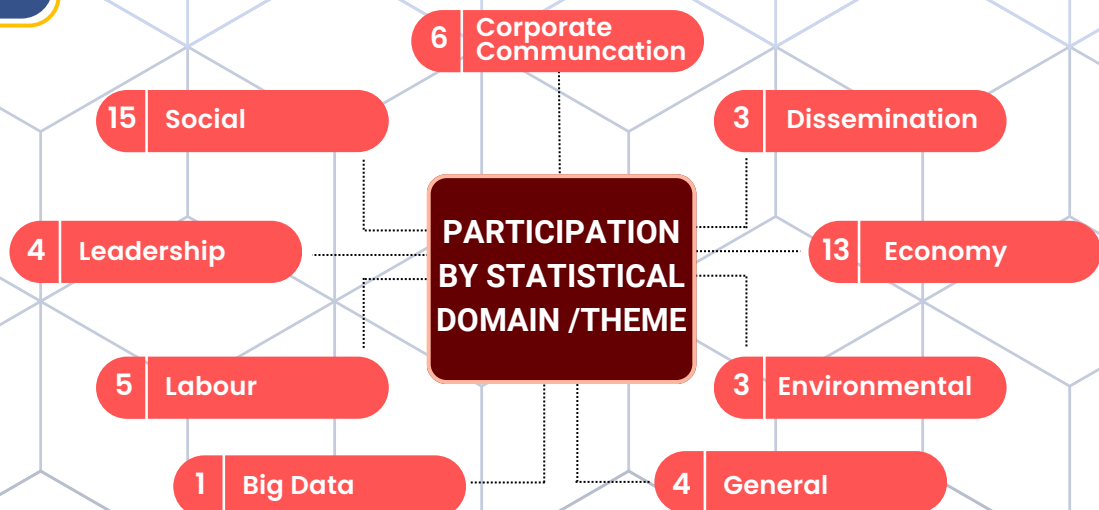

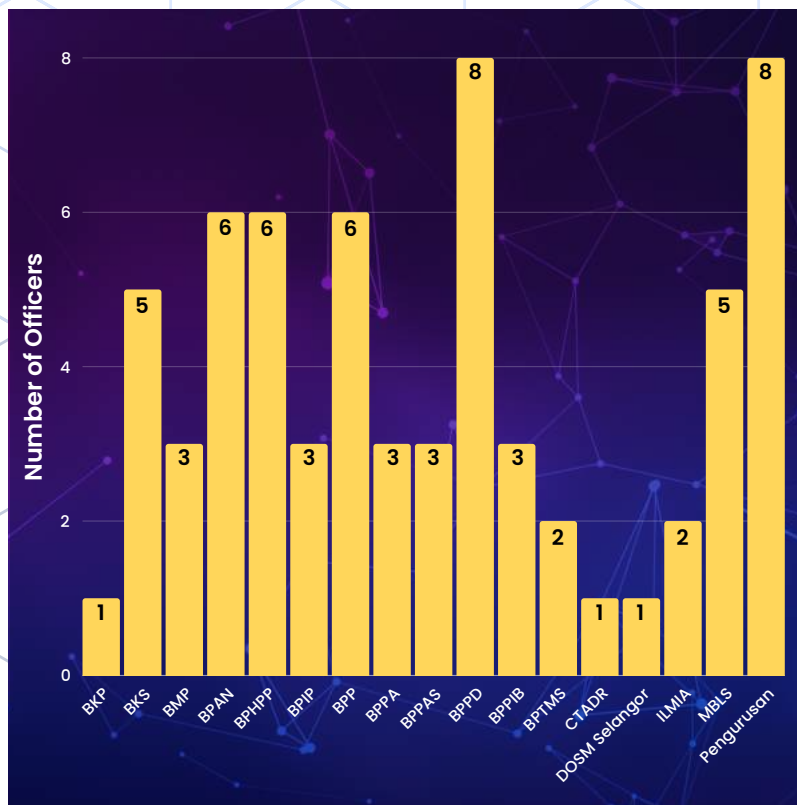
Participation by Gender



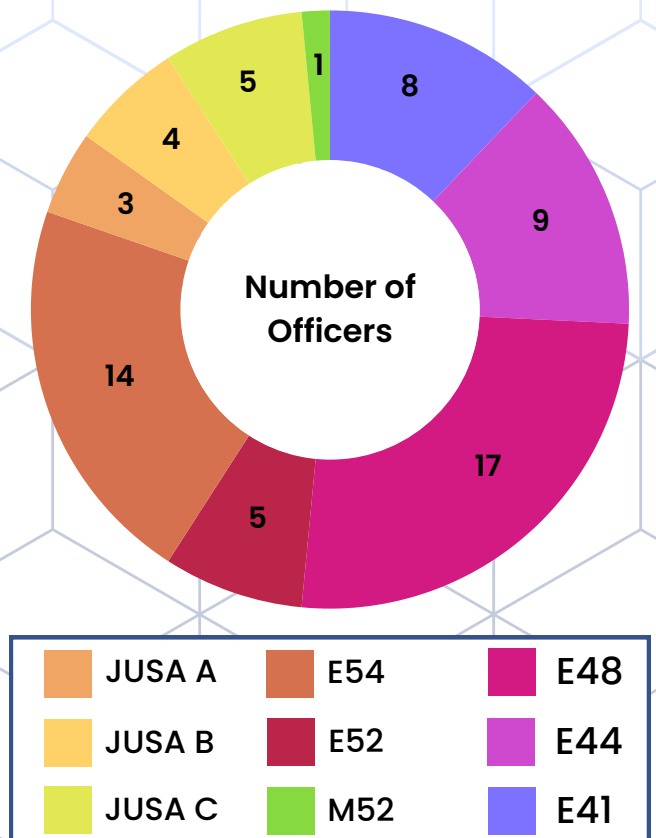

Involvement of the Subject Matter Divisions



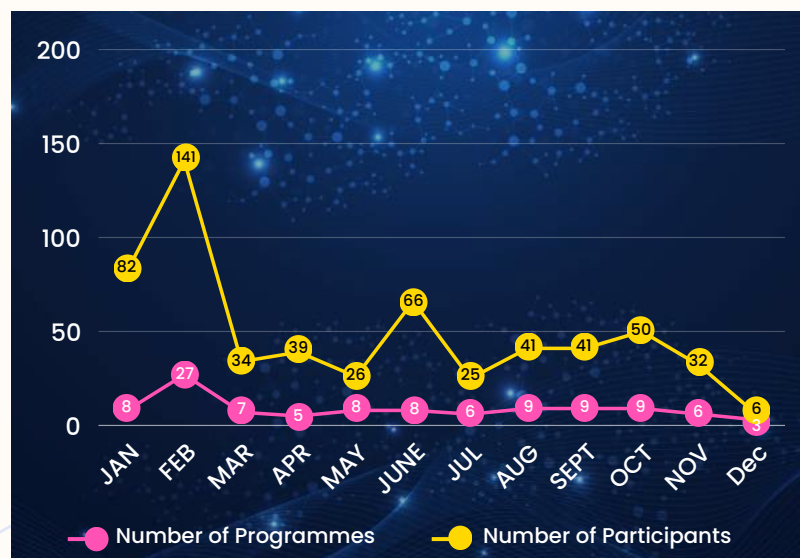
Involvement by Positions

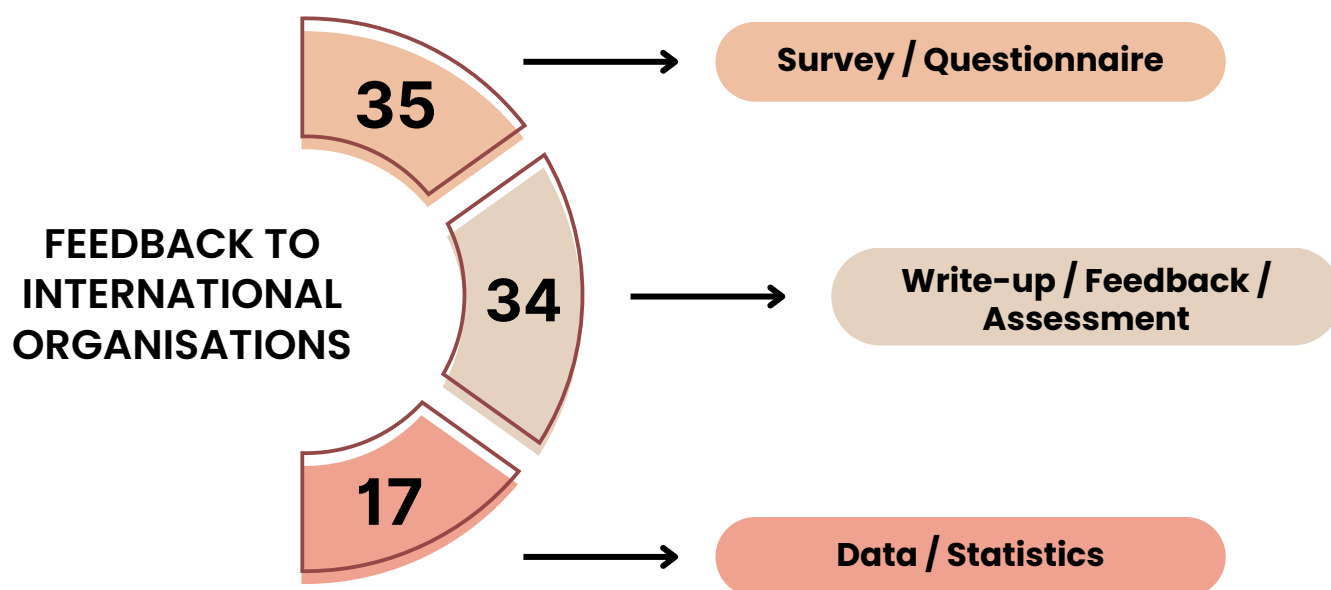

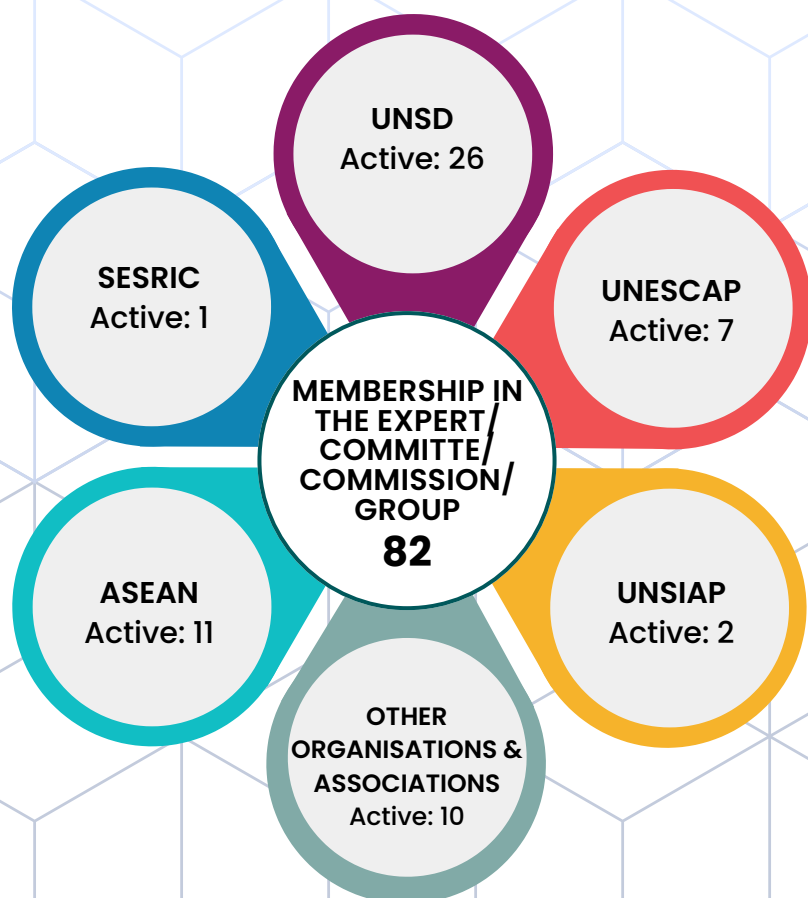

ABOUT UN STATCOM

The United Nations Statistical Commission (UN StatCom), established in 1947, is the highest body of the global statistical system bringing together the Chief Statisticians from member states from around the world. It is the highest decision-making body for international statistical activities, responsible for setting statistical standards and the development of concepts and methods, including their implementation at the national and international levels. The Statistical Commission oversees the work of the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD), and it is a Functional Commission of the UN Economic and Social Council.



MANDATE

Resolution 3 of June 8, 2022, reaffirmed the Statistical Commission as the primary body for coordinating global statistical programs and emphasizing adaptability to changing statistical ecosystems. It calls on the UN statistical system:

- Ensuring that the work in the field of statistics and data is adaptive to the changing statistical and data ecosystem.
- Reporting statistics and data across all domains to the Commission.
- Promoting technological innovation, coherence, comparability, and data privacy.
- Highlights the importance of partnerships and requests the Commission to facilitate discussions, share best practices, develop standards, support national statistical systems, build capacity, advocate for professional statistics, and ensure ongoing innovation.
- Underscores adherence to the Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics by Member States and relevant organizations, emphasizing support for developing countries in strengthening their statistical and data systems.

DOSM PARTICIPATION

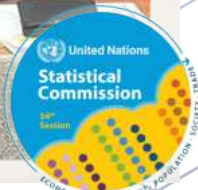
DOSM represented Malaysia at the commission, led by YBhg Dato' Sri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician, and accompanied by Ms Ezatul Nisha Abdul Rahman, Director of Strategic Communication and International Division.

Throughout the session, a comprehensive discussion ensued on 32 agenda items, supported by 43 documents, resulting in pivotal decisions aimed at enhancing the global statistical system. Malaysia demonstrated unwavering commitment by actively engaging in the session, submitting 29 national statements in writing, and delivering 7 oral statements. This steadfast participation underscores Malaysia's dedication to advancing statistical practices on a global scale.

In addition to the primary sessions, Malaysia actively engaged in discussions on the latest advancements and contributed its insights as a member of expert groups across various meetings. These included the International Comparison Program (ICP) Governing Board, Bureau Members of the ESCAP Committee on Statistics, the OIC Statistical Commission (OIC StatCom), the UN Committee of Experts on Big Data and Data Science, and the Open House on Big Data and Data Science for Official Statistics, along with the Multidimensional Poverty Data: Post-Pandemic forum. This extensive involvement demonstrates Malaysia's commitment to staying abreast of emerging trends and actively shaping discussions at the forefront of statistical practice.

HIGH-LEVEL STATISTICAL COMMISSIONS

SESSION OF THE STATISTICAL INSTITUTE FOR ASIA AND THE PACIFIC (SIAP) GOVERNING COUNCIL

The **Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific (SIAP)** was founded in 1970 in Tokyo as a professional statistical training center for the Asia Pacific region. Initially established under the Japanese Government, in April 1995, it was granted the status of a subsidiary body under the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP).

MALAYSIA AS THE HOST COUNTRY

Malaysia hosted three significant UNSIAP events consecutively from 13 to 15 December 2023 in Kuala Lumpur, namely the 19th Session of the Governing Council of the Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific (GC SIAP), the 18th Management Seminar for the Heads of National Statistical Offices (NSOs) in Asia and the Pacific, and the Training of Trainers on the Quality of Statistics for Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Following a vote by Asia Pacific member countries on 24 May 2022 in Bangkok, Malaysia has been appointed as a member of the GC for the term 2022-2024. The Chief Statistician Malaysia, YBhg. Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin attended the 18th GC UNSIAP as a member and was appointed as the Chairman of its session, which took place from December 12 to 15, 2022, in Chiba, Japan. Additionally, Malaysia has been offered the opportunity to host the 19th Session in 2023 in Kuala Lumpur.

Witness a historic moment! The events have brought together 97 delegates from 32 countries from Asia and the Pacific region, along with six international agencies, to Malaysia. This has created a unique opportunity for us to collaborate and positively impact our region.

ABOUT

UNSIAP, initially established as the Asian Statistical Institute under the Japanese Government in April 1995, was granted the status of a subsidiary body under ESCAP. The establishment of a GC allowed UNSIAP to contribute to the development of statistical human capital and capacity for the benefit of government employees of member countries at the Asia Pacific level.

OBJECTIVE GC

GC will convene annually to assess and improve the governance, administrative and financial status of the UNSIAP. Additionally, they will evaluate, adopt and implement UNSIAP's short-term and long-term annual programs and activities that will benefit the member countries of the Asia Pacific region, aligning with UNSIAP's Strategic Plan for 2021-2025. The ESCAP Executive Secretary will present the report of the GC meeting to the ESCAP Commission during its yearly session.

MEMBERSHIP GC

In accordance with its Statute, the GC consists of a representative designated by the Government of Japan and eight representatives nominated by other members and associate members of ESCAP elected by the Commission. At its seventy-eight session, the Commission elected new members of the GC for the term 2022 to 2024, which are Bangladesh, China, India, Japan (Host Country), Malaysia, Philippines, Republic of Korea, Thailand and Vietnam.



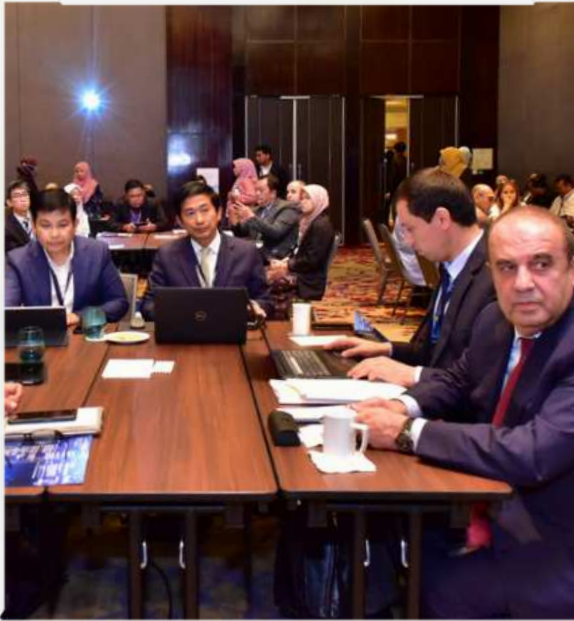

12TH SESSION OF THE OIC STATISTICAL COMMISSION (OIC-STATCOM)

3- 4 October 2023 | Jeddah Saudi Arabia

SESRIC, in its capacity as the Secretariat of the OIC-StatCom, organised its 12TH Session in collaboration with General Authority for Statistics (GASTAT) of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Islamic Development Bank (IsDB). This significant gathering brought together 64 participants from the National Statistical Offices (NSOs) representing 39 OIC countries, along with delegates from five prominent international and regional organizations.

Malaysia, led by YBhg. Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, the Chief Statistician, accompanied by Mr. Azizul Abllah, Assistant Director of the Integrity Unit (cum Special Officer to the Chief Statistician), made noteworthy contributions to the discussions. Particularly, Malaysia was elected as the Vice Chair of the Bureau Member for the Asia Group.

During the session, DOSM highlighted its successful integration of geospatial technologies in census activities and the development of Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 8 Indicators, specifically promoting decent work and economic growth. In open discussions with fellow member states, DOSM provided valuable insights into the Commission's ongoing activities and shared experiences that could benefit other nations' statistical endeavours.

The OIC-StatCom was established in 2011 to promote cooperation among NSOs of member countries. SESRIC plays a pivotal role in organizing annual sessions and overseeing the activities of various working groups. By working together and sharing knowledge, the OIC-StatCom plays a crucial role in strengthening national statistical systems and facilitating the development of robust strategies and policies across member countries.

13TH ASEAN COMMUNITY STATISTICAL SYSTEM COMMITTEE (ACSS)

22-24 November 2023 | Jakarta, Indonesia

- The ACSS is a partnership between and among the national statistical systems of the ASEAN Member States (AMSS), the ASEAN Community Councils, and the ASEAN Secretariat.
- The ACSS Committee is the highest policy-making and coordinating body on statistical matters in the ASEAN region. It was formally established in 2011 as a reconstitution of the ASEAN Heads of Statistical Offices Meeting (AHSOM).
- The ACSS Committee shall be responsible for strengthening regional statistical cooperation in support of the ASEAN Community, and provide professional guidance on the production, dissemination, and communication of ASEAN statistics.
- The ACSS Committee meets once a year or more, as necessary while Chairmanship is on a rotating basis, following the ASEAN chairmanship.

Malaysia participated in the meeting as a member of the ACSS. The delegation was headed by YBhg. Datin Seri Rozita Talha, the Deputy Chief Statistician of Malaysia, oversees the Economic Programme, along with Ms Ezatul Nisha Abdul Rahman, the Director of Strategic Communication and International Division, as a member of the ACSS-SCPC.

During the session, ACSS Malaysia representatives presented two key topics. Firstly, they discussed Malaysia's strategies for adapting to the changing ASEAN economic landscape. Secondly, as Chair of the Working Group on System National Accounts (WGSNA) from 2021-2024, Malaysia provided an update on the group's activities in 2023.

Working Group on System of National Accounts (WGSNA)

- Progress of WGSNA Multi-Year Work Plan (MYP) 2022-2025 implementation at regional and national level agreed on several activities which are (continue):
 - WGSNA agreed on the dissemination of annual GDP by Expenditure, with more detailed breakdown on the components, and data submission on GDP by Income in 2024.
 - WGSNA agreed on the template for dissemination of ASEAN GDP Expenditure in 2024.
 - Data submission template for annual and quarterly GDP Production and Expenditure will be improved for the next data submission in 2024.
- The ASEAN guideline for the implementation of SNA 2008 was updated and suggested to adopt the Gross National Income (GNI) classification position based on the World Bank classification.
- The SNA expert from Arise Plus developed the gap analysis on the data quality assessment report on national accounts based on the assessment from country visits, technical assistance, and virtual discussions. The report presented by ASEANtats during the WGSNA meeting for AMS references in improving the national accounts compilation.
- AMS has submitted an updated list of needs and expertise under the ASEAN Help ASEAN Framework (AHAF) and will continue to start AHAF for capacity-building in 2024.

Abstract
DOSH will deliver a presentation titled "Tailoring a Comprehensive Malaysia Population Sampling Frame".

Establishing household survey sample design is complex due to the challenges of developing and updating quality frames. Population and housing censuses, surveys and administrative records are the main sources for constructing a good household sampling frame. Traditionally, immigration block as a Primary Sampling Unit (PSU) and living quarters as a Secondary Sampling Unit (SSU) method are still used in household sampling design for developing countries. Due to the dynamic changes in population composition in each enumeration block in Malaysia, especially in urban areas, innovation in household sampling design is required in order to address this issue, a solution for household frame sampling design in Putrajaya was carried out by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM). The new sampling frame of population data for the simulation purposes of these sources namely Malaysia Statistical Address Register (MSAR), Malaysia Population and Housing Census 2020 and administrative tax data from Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia. The primary challenge from this study is having an incomplete identification system, as all statistical records are from different sources. To overcome this, addresses are used as the second identifier to match the individual data. However, hurdle remain due to the different address structure between sources, in order to have a comprehensive population frame to improve sampling design and sample selection, a structured population profile is being developed known as Malaysia Statistical Population Profile (MSPP). This will produce a better quality granular data.

**The 54th United Nations Statistical Commission (UNSC):
OpenDOSM NextGen at the global platform as a tool to bridge the
knowledge gap among citizens**

PUTRAJAYA, MARCH 8, 2023 – Malaysia introduced "OpenDOSM NextGen" to the global statistical communities during the 54th session of the United Nations Statistical Commission (UNSC), convened in person from February 26 to March 3, 2023. At the side event "Beyond Open Data: Harnessing Openness for Use and Impact", Malaysia shared its efforts to create a scholarly society by accessing social, economic and environmental information in one platform to encourage people to make evidence-based decisions to secure sustained economic growth, a healthy environment and inclusive social development.

Following two years of virtual meetings, the Statistics Division of the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs organised in-person session and side events that drew nearly **500 delegates from 98 countries, 37 organisations, and three non-governmental organisations** to discuss the significance and standardisation of statistics for the benefit of all citizens, governments, and non-governmental organisations worldwide in advancing "Better Data, Better Lives."

UNSC is the apex entity of the global statistical system met once a year to advance official statistical data and information. It is made up of approximately 193 UN member countries and international organisations. UNSC significantly impacts the development of national statistics systems where statistical standards, guidelines, classifications, methodologies, techniques and concepts are created, debated, and accepted for use at the national and international levels.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM), represented Malaysia at the commission under the leadership of YBhg Dato' Sri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician, and in the company of Ms Ezatul Nisha Abdul Rahman, Director of Strategic Communication and International Division. A total of 32 agenda items with 43 supporting documents were discussed and finalised, resulting in crucial decisions for developing the global statistical system. Malaysia's full engagement and contribution continued during the session, with the submission of **29 written national statements and the delivery of 7 oral statements**.

Malaysia highlighted to the commission the importance of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, Big Data and Data Science, Economic Statistics, Social

Statistics, National Accounts, Regional statistical development and Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics, and recent DOSM initiatives to improve the statistics above. Malaysia expresses its support for establishing a new Friends of the Chair group on social and demographic statistics to work together on generating initiatives and methods to strengthen the role of social statistics for the 2030 Agenda and beyond. To balance relevance to national policymaking and promote international comparability across nations, Malaysia also commits to identifying the indicators and subjects for disaggregation applicable in all countries.

Aside from the main sessions, Malaysia discussed the most recent developments and shared its perspective as a member of expert groups at meetings of the International Comparison Program (ICP) Governing Board, Bureau Members of the ESCAP Committee on Statistics, the OIC Statistical Commission (OIC StatCom), the UN Committee of Experts on Big Data and Data Science of Official Statistics Open House on Big Data and Data Science, and Multidimensional Poverty Data: Post-Pandemic.

Dr. Uzir stated that "modernising official statistics through digitalisation as well as leveraging administrative data sources is essential for the national statistical office to remain relevant in fulfilling the growing demands for high-quality, granular, and real-time data. In this regard, Malaysia, through the Department of Statistics, has **exhaustively transformed the statistical operation by adopting digitalisation** such as online data collection, big data analytics, and data communication through dashboards and open data platforms".

MALAYSIA ELECTED AS VICE CHAIR OF THE 12TH OIC STATISTICAL COMMISSION (OIC-STATCOM) SECOND HIGHEST-LEVEL INTERGOVERNMENTAL FORUM

PUTRAJAYA, OCTOBER 6, 2023 – Malaysia, through the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM), has been elected as the Vice Chair of the Bureau Member of the 12th OIC Statistical Commission (OIC-StatCom), an intergovernmental forum of paramount significance in the global statistical community. This significant achievement is a testament to Malaysia's dedication to advancing statistical activities and its commitment to international cooperation and diplomacy. **YBhg. Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, the Chief Statistician, led Malaysia's delegates at the Commission in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia.**

The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) held its 12th OIC-StatCom on October 3rd and 4th, 2023 to enhance statistical capabilities through global collaboration in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. This significant event gathered the member states' National Statistical Office (NSO) leaders, emphasising the significance of sharing knowledge and learning to produce accurate and reliable data for informed decision-making. The session was meticulously organised by The Statistical, Economic and Social Research and Training Centre for Islamic Countries (SESRIC) as the Secretariat, hosted by the General Authority for Statistics (GASTAT) of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, in collaboration with the Islamic Development Bank (IDB). The event saw the participation from NSOs representing OIC countries along with representatives from both international and regional organisations.

The 12th Commission appointed Cameroon as the Chair (Africa Group), while Malaysia (Asia Group), Saudi Arabia (Arab Group), and Palestine (permanent member) were appointed as Vice-Chair. The SESRIC serves as the rapporteur. Elections are conducted based on the geographical distribution among the OIC countries. In 2018 and 2019, Malaysia held the esteemed title of 7th and 8th OIC-StatCom Chairman as well as served as Vice Chair of the Working Group responsible for developing the OIC-StatCom New Strategic Vision for 2030 and Action Program for 2021-2025.

The 12th Commission has acknowledged and commended member states' significant achievements in utilising geospatial technologies to enhance census activities, monitoring Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 8 and promoting e-learning for statistical capacity development. The custodians of these statistical domains

presented their most recent initiatives, advancements, methodologies, and breakthroughs globally. The agenda of the Commission was thoughtfully curated to meet the needs of member nations in bridging the statistical capacity deficit, thus facilitating the enhancement of their National Statistical System (NSS).

This year, DOSM shared its successful use of geospatial technologies to enhance census activities and the development of SDG 8 Indicators, focusing on decent work and economic growth in the country. During open discussions with other member states, DOSM provided valuable insights on the Commission's activities.

In 2020, DOSM signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with SESRIC to strengthen their collaboration to improve statistical capabilities among the OIC member states. Under the Statistical Capacity Building Program (StatCaB), DOSM has delivered capacity-building training in various socio-economic fields for OIC member countries. In 2023, DOSM has conducted nine statistical training courses, webinars, and workshops, covering topics such as SDG 9 Indicators (Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure), SDG 1 Indicators (No Poverty), and SDG 7 Indicators (Affordable and Clean Energy), as well as data on the Islamic Financial Services Sector, basic statistics for diplomats, and international trade statistics and balance of payments.

According to Dr Uzir, the recognition of Malaysia is a reflection of the unwavering dedication of DOSM towards international cooperation, with the aim of promoting official statistics and working towards the Agenda 2030 goal of "Leave No One Behind". PUTRAJAYA, OCTOBER 11, 2023 – Malaysia, through the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM), has been elected as the Co-Chair of the Regional Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting on International Comparison Program (ICP) 2021 for Asia and the Pacific on October 9, 2023. YBhg. Datuk Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, the Chief Statistician, led Malaysia's delegates at the meeting held in Kuala Lumpur.

The International Comparison Program (ICP) is a global initiative coordinated by the World Bank. The programme produces estimates of GDP and its several components based on purchasing power parities (PPPs), providing real comparisons of economies' outputs which are better measures than the exchange-rate-based comparisons. Furthermore, the PPPs derived from ICP have found several uses including in measuring global poverty, and several other indicators of the Sustainable Development Goals Agenda.

The Regional Advisory Board (RAB) of the International Comparison Program (ICP) is a consultative body comprising experts and representatives from participating countries and organisations within a specific region. The RAB's primary role is to provide guidance and recommendations to enhance the quality, relevance, and impact of ICP data and analysis within the region.

In the ICP for Asia and the Pacific, the RAB is established to provide advice to the ICP Asia and the Pacific regional coordinator. The board includes representatives of economy-level and regional stakeholders. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) is taking the regional lead in implementing ICP Asia and the Pacific with a total of 22 of economies are participating in the programme.

There were seven (7) RAB members from various National Implementing Agencies (NIA) in the ICP RAB consisting of National Institute of Statistics Cambodia, International Statistical Information Centre National Bureau of Statistics People's Republic of China, Census and Statistics Department Hong Kong China, National Statistical Office, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, India, Department of Statistics of Malaysia, National Bureau of Statistics Maldives and Trade Policy and Strategy Office Thailand. Recommendations on methods was made to ensure reliable, comparable and consistent data within Asia and the Pacific region.

Since the beginning of 2021, all participating economies have made considerable effort in conducting price collection despite a challenging environment due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Thus, alternative methods like phone interviews, emails, and web scraping were introduced. Despite these challenges, DOSM remains fully committed to ensuring the success of ICP 2021.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, YBhg. Datuk Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, who led the Malaysia economy at the current ICP 2021 cycle, reaffirmed DOSM's commitment in providing reliable data in order to ensure the successful completion of the current ICP 2021 cycle and the publication of results by the first quarter of year 2024. DOSM has shown its milestones for attending all the regional workshops, preparation of items lists based on ICP surveys sectors, review and validation of data, preliminary results and the country's report.

THE 13TH SESSION OF THE ASEAN COMMUNITY STATISTICAL SYSTEM (ACSS) COMMITTEE



HEADS OF THE ASEAN NATIONAL STATISTICAL OFFICES ATTENDED THE 13TH SESSION OF THE ASEAN COMMUNITY STATISTICAL SYSTEM (ACSS) COMMITTEE, 22ND TO 24TH NOVEMBER 2023, JAKARTA, INDONESIA

PUTRAJAYA, 1ST DECEMBER 2023 – The 13th Session of the ASEAN Community Statistical System (ACSS13) Committee was held from 22nd to 24th November 2023 in Jakarta, Indonesia and attended by the Heads of the ASEAN National Statistical Offices (NSOs) as well as International Organisations and Development Partners. The meeting was hosted by Badan Pusat Statistik (Statistics Indonesia) supported by the ASEAN Secretariat. The ACSS was established in 2011 and has been continuing its efforts to provide relevant, timely and comparable ASEAN statistics in support of ASEAN integration monitoring and evidence-based policy and decision-making. The ACSS consistently strengthens its cooperation to enhance the statistical capacities of the ASEAN Member States (AMS) and the ASEAN Secretariat.

Malaysia was represented by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) led by the Deputy Chief Statistician Malaysia, Economic Programme, YBhg. Datuk Seri Rozita Taha as a representative of the Chief Statistician Malaysia, YBhg. Datuk Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin as a member of ACSS, accompanied by the Director of Strategic Communication and International Division, Ms. Ezatul Nisha Abdul Rahman as a member of ACSS Sub-Committee Planning and Coordination Committee (ACSS-SOPC) member. DOSM's participation in the ACSS meeting was to provide input and feedback for the ACSS Strategic Plan 2021-2025, the Annual Work Plan (AWP), progress in data coordination and other issues related to statistical development. The ACSS Strategic Plan is a framework prepared to strengthen the ASEAN statistical mechanism and system through a strategic implementation plan for a period of 5 years. It aims to ensure the effectiveness of the coordination, production, dissemination, and communication of statistics in ASEAN Member States (AMS) and also ASEAN. There are four (4) main strategies to better meet the

data needs of the ASEAN Community through statistical cooperation, capacity building and contribution to the development of statistics at the global and regional levels.

The theme for ACSS13 was "Navigating Official Statistics towards ASEAN as the Epicentrum of Growth". ACSS Malaysia representatives made a presentation during the Agenda 10 Session: National Experience Sharing Session on the topic "Malaysia's Strategies and Responses to the Dynamic Change of Economy in ASEAN as the Epicentrum of Growth". Besides, Malaysia as the Chairman of the Working Group on System National Accounts (NAGSNA) for the year 2021-2024, presented the WG's progress/implementation of activities throughout the year 2023.

In addition, Malaysia through DOSM was also actively involved in implementing ASEAN Help ASEAN Framework (AHAF) courses under each ACSS Working Group, which helped increase capacity building among other ASEAN members in line with the ACSS Strategic Plan 2021-2025. Four (4) AHAF's were organized throughout 2022 until 2023, among which were Capacity Building Under AHAF - Sharing on the Sustainable Development Goals 9.1.1 & 12.2 (SDG 9.1.1 & SDG 12.2) and Capacity Building under ASEAN Help ASEAN Framework (AHAF): Online Training on Linking Business with Trade Data. Malaysia appreciates ASEANStats and AMS's efforts in implementing the AHAF courses under each ACSS Working Group, which helped improve capacity building among the members. Malaysia strongly encourages expanding the AHAF sharing platform and ensures that each implementation of the programme or activity achieves the desired goal.

ACSS13 was held consecutively with the launch of the UN Regional Hub on Big Data and Data Science for Asia and the Pacific in Indonesia and the opening of the Conference on Data Science and Official Statistics (CDSOS) on 24 November 2023. The UN Regional Hub on Big Data and Data Science for Asia and the Pacific would meet virtually once or twice a year to help guide the work of the regional hub. In line with the invitation to DOSM to join the Advisory Committee for the regional hub on big data and data science for Asia and the Pacific, DOSM's presence during the ACSS13 session was also to discuss the development of the regional hub.

Malaysia is looking forward to participate in the 14th Session of the ASEAN Community Statistical System (ACSS14) Committee which will be held in 2024 and will be chaired by Lao PDR.

PUTRAJAYA, 13 December 2023 – Malaysia, represented by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM), was the Chairman of the 18th Session of the Governing Council of the Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific (GC SIAP) in 2022 in Chiba, Japan. Following a vote by Asia Pacific member countries on 24 May 2022 in Bangkok, Malaysia has been appointed as a member of the GC for the term 2022-2024, and has been offered the opportunity to host the 19th Session in 2023 in Kuala Lumpur. The annual GC SIAP meetings play a pivotal role in assessing UNSIAP's governance, financial status, and programme initiatives, aligning with UNSIAP's Strategic Plan for 2021-2025.

According to the Chief Statistician of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Malaysia is privileged to host the 19th Session of the Governing Council of the Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific and the 18th Management Seminar for the Heads of National Statistical Offices in Asia and the Pacific: Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics (FPOS) in Kuala Lumpur. These two events, organised by SIAP, in collaboration with the Statistics Division of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP), the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD) and the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will serve as a testament to our commitment in promoting global cooperation and the advancement of statistics."

The workshop will provide an opportunity for participants to gain in-depth knowledge of core concepts on quality assurance, the United Nations reference national quality assurance framework (NQAF) and the implementation of NQAF. In addition, the workshop will provide knowledge on the International Monetary Fund's Data Quality Assessment Framework (DQAF) and the enhanced General Data Dissemination System (e-GDDS), with the overall aim of strengthening the capacity to produce a set of statistics including indicators, to track and monitor Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)."

In collaboration with the Forest Research Institute Malaysia and the Forestry Department of Peninsular Malaysia, a tree planting activity will be held on 14 December 2023 following the awareness of participants on the corporate social responsibility towards the environment and nature.
