## Thirty-fourth Report to Congress on the Alaska Pipeline

### **I. Executive Summary**

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) submits this report pursuant to section 1810 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (EPAct 2005).<sup>1</sup> Section 1810 of EPAct 2005 requires that the Commission submit to Congress semi-annual reports describing the progress made in licensing and constructing an Alaska natural gas pipeline and any impediments thereto.

This report provides an update from the Commission's Thirty-third Report, submitted in February 2022.

### **II. Status Report**

As stated in previous reports, at TransCanada Alaska Company, LLC's request, the Commission terminated the prefile review process for the Alaska Pipeline Project in Docket No. PF09-11-000. Commission staff has no further progress to report.
