BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 4, 2024, the Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company ("Applicant"), Cheyenne, Wyoming, filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Scotts Bluff County.

Applicant proposes to construct, 7.39 miles, 3 phase, 5 wire ground, 139.43/230kv, wye multi-grounded connected, electric line in Scotts Bluff County.

## O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

The Commission finds that:

1. Applicant has filed Route Map Exhibit A, which shows the route of the proposed lines, the side of the roadway to be occupied and the location and ownership of all utilities, which may be in conflict, crossed or paralleled by the proposed lines.

2. Applicant has filed Specifications (Exhibit B), which will govern the construction of the electric lines and have sufficient details to portray the type and manner of the construction for the proposed lines.

3. In the construction, operation and maintenance of the proposed electric transmission lines, Applicant has filed a verified affidavit that the project will conform to the requirements of the latest edition of the National Electrical Safety Code, the laws of the State of Nebraska and the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

4. The Nebraska Department of Aeronautics has filed a letter waiving objections to the proposed line. According to the application and the Nebraska Department of Aeronautics, there is

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no licensed airport which will be affected by the construction and operation of the electric lines proposed herein.

5. According to the application, the utilities that will be affected by the construction and operation of the proposed electric line are:

Roosevelt Public Power District, Scotts Bluff, NE  
Basin Electric Power Cooperative, Bismarck, ND  
Western Area Power Administration, Lakewood, CO

6. The Applicant has filed documents showing the consent of the involved parties.

Based upon the information provided in the application and verified by affidavit, and other filings in this docket, the Commission finds that this application should be granted.

### O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. E-2530 be granted and the Cheyenne Light, Fuel and Power Company, be, and it is hereby, authorized to construct, operate and maintain the proposed electric transmission line in Scotts Bluff County in accordance with its application, Route Map (Exhibit A) and Specifications (Exhibit B), which by this reference are made a part hereof, all subject to the Rules and Regulations of this Commission and to the terms and conditions of the waivers filed with this application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an immediate supplemental application be made if it develops that the lines will not be built in their entirety in accordance with the Commission's order. A supplemental application is required for any and all changes in line routing, voltage and/or design.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the construction authorized in this order will not be entirely completed within 24 months of the date of this order, Applicant shall apply for an extension of time to complete the authorized construction showing good cause for such extension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a completion notice shall be filed with this Commission as soon as the proposed lines have been completed and are ready to be energized. With this completion

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notice, there should be a report of any line authorized, which was not built.
