OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 29, 2022, B.J.Z., Inc., d/b/a Checker Cab Company ("Applicant"), Norfolk, Nebraska, filed an application seeking authority to extend its common carrier authority to transport passengers by sedan in open class between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. HHS Designation is Yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 4, 2022.

On April 7, 2022, a timely protest was filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc. ("Camelot") and Triumph Transportation, Inc ("Triumph"). On April 14, 2022, a timely protest was filed by Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab (together "Protestant"). On July 21, 2022, the Hearing Officer entered an Order granting the Protests.

On April 19, 2023, I entered a Hearing Officer's Order retracting and reissuing the granting of Applicant's request to amend its application to restrict its requested service territory for its proposed open class services to its already existing service territories under Certificate No. B-1433. On April 19, 2023, the Protestants filed Motions for Leave to Withdraw their protests based upon Applicant's amendment request, respectively.

Based on the above, I find that the Motions for Leave to Withdraw filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., Triumph Transportation, Inc., and Comstock Corporation d/b/a Action Cab should be granted and said protests be considered withdrawn.
