## ORDER REVOKING A REGISTRATION

The Commissioner of Financial Institutions ("Commissioner") has reported to the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") that Carmen Mayorga, d/b/a Tienda Latina Emily ("Defendant") is registered to engage in business as a check casher under Chapter 21 of Title 6.2 of the Code of Virginia ("Code"); that the Defendant failed to pay her 2023 annual registration fee, which was due on or before July 1, 2023, in violation of § 6.2-2103 of the Code; and that the Commissioner, pursuant to delegated authority, gave written notice to the Defendant on December 26, 2023, of: (1) the Commissioner's intention to recommend revocation of the Defendant's registration, and (2) the requirement to submit a written request for a hearing, if desired, on or before January 26, 2024. As of the date of this Order, the Defendant has not requested a hearing in this matter. The Commissioner has recommended that the Commission enter an order revoking the Defendant's registration to engage in business as a check casher pursuant to § 6.2-2110 of the Code.

NOW THE COMMISSION, having considered this matter, is of the opinion and finds that the Defendant has failed to pay her 2023 annual registration fee, in violation of § 6.2-2103 of the Code. revoked.
(2) This case is dismissed.
