Electricity distribution licences annual performance reporting

2023 Handbook and datasheets

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the following documents to assist electricity licensees to prepare and lodge their 2022/23 annual performance reports with the ERA:

The ERA's performance reporting handbooks set out requirements for licensees' annual performance reports.

The ERA has amended the handbook and network quality and reliability code datasheets to include new reporting requirements for stand-alone power systems.

Electricity distribution licensees who supply small-use customers are required to provide their annual performance report and complete and provide performance data to the ERA for each year ending 30 June.¹

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¹ A 'small use customer' is a customer who consumes no more than 160 MWh of electricity per year.
