BEA Enhances its Cross-Boundary and Digital Banking Services

Mongkok Branch Serves Hong Kong and Cross-Boundary Customers With Fresh New Look

Number of all-new cross-boundary customers up nearly 30% in the first half of the year compared to pre-pandemic levels

Hong Kong, 29th **September, 2023** – The Bank of East Asia, Limited ("BEA" or "the Bank") has redesigned its Mongkok branch, which occupies a key position on Nathan Road, to provide customers with comprehensive services in a new setting, while enhancing cross-boundary connectivity.

Located at the Bank of East Asia Mongkok Building, the BEA Mongkok branch first opened its doors in 1962. The branch provides counter services, 24/7 self-service banking, safe deposit boxes, and specialist centres for business, SupremeGold and SupremeGold Private customers.

BEA has seen double-digit growth in the number of SupremeGold Private and SupremeGold accounts. For this reason, the Mongkok Branch has opened a SupremeGold Private Centre, the first of its kind in Kowloon, to provide affluent customers with one-stop services covering wealth management, cross-boundary finance and commercial banking services."

The Mongkok branch has created a digital zone at its ground floor, introducing customers to the latest products and developments in BEA's digital banking. Demonstration guides show customers how to open an account from their mobile device or how to perform everyday transactions. Digital specialists are available to help customers quickly complete the basic settings of their digital banking service.

In addition, the Mongkok branch houses a cross-boundary wealth management centre, which, paired with branches of BEA China in the Chinese Mainland, offers customers comprehensive cross-boundary financial services. These include all-round investment and banking services, such as assisting qualified Chinese Mainland investors from the Greater Bay Area in setting up a BEA investment account and purchasing eligible investment products sold by BEA through the cross-boundary Wealth Management Connect (Southbound) scheme, without the need to visit Hong Kong.

Using the account opening attestation service at the branch, Hong Kong residents can

apply to open a Mainland Personal Type II Bank Account* and enjoy the convenience of spending and paying with mobile wallets in the Mainland. The Mongkok branch equally handles cross-boundary mortgage enquiries to help Hong Kong residents get a mortgage for properties on the Chinese Mainland.

"Following the reopening of the boundary between the Mainland and Hong Kong, there was an increase of nearly 30% in the first half of the year in terms of the number of allnew cross-boundary customers compared to pre-pandemic levels, and there was a marked growth in the deposits and wealth management portfolios of cross-boundary customers" says Bruce Leung, Head of Branch Distribution and Services Department at the Bank. "This shows the strong customer demand for cross-boundary financial services, and the Mongkok branch is part of BEA's strategic focus on personal banking and wealth management. The newly created space offers a more comfortable environment to both local customers and visitors to Hong Kong," adds Leung.

During the Golden Week, from 3rd to 6th October, 2023, BEA will extend the business hours of its Mongkok, Shatin Plaza, Tsim Sha Tsui and Causeway Bay branches to 6pm, while the Sheung Shui Branch will remain open seven days a week until 29th October, 2023. Cross-boundary customers who successfully open an all-new SupremeGold account and deposit a designated amount will receive a welcome offer of up to HK\$3,000[^], in addition to a mini Octopus card for adults (with a stored value of HK\$100)[#].
